FCBA partner of the EASIMS project Integrated Management System in the furniture sector

EASIMS is a project that aims to help companies in the furniture sector to set up and maintain an Integrated Management System (IMS) for Quality, Safety and Environment. FCBA is a partner in this project financed by the European Erasmus+ programme and coordinated by the CENFIM cluster for a period of 28 months.



The objective of the EASIMS project is to train QSE (quality, safety and environment) managers in SMEs so that they learn to implement and maintain an integrated quality, safety and environment management system. Traditionally, companies have managed these processes separately, while treating them jointly increases efficiency and saves maintenance costs.

EASIMS' aim is to focus on the training and facilitation of an IMS. While it is important to know the rules, it is essential to adopt the most appropriate processes to apply them in a furniture SME. The project will identify the skills needed by an IMS manager, establish a training curriculum and develop the content of the training available in e-learning. In addition,

it will set up a computer tool to facilitate the animation and monitoring of an IMS.

This innovative approach will enable SMEs to implement a pragmatic management system that will bring efficiency to the company and even meet certification requirements.

The CENFIM cluster is the coordinator of a consortium comprising: the European Federation of Furniture Manufacturers (UEA), the Meroni Vocational Training Institute (Italy), the Association of Manufacturers AMUEBLA of Murcia (Spain), the Technological Institute FCBA (France), the software company DANMAR (Poland) and the University Rovira i Virgili of Tarragona (Spain).
